

- 2 Be it further enacted that any person who shall refuse to obey the lawful or reasonable commands of such Overseer during the time he is required to work shall be liable at the discretion of such Overseer to be dismissed from the Road or Highway and the Overseer may allow him such credit for the part or portion of the day he may have worked as he may deem him entitled to =
- 3 Be it further enacted that any person liable to perform Statute labor on the Highways who from sickness, infirmity or indigent circumstances shall think himself unable to perform such labor may (within four days after receiving notice from the Overseer of Highways as provided in the first section of this Big Law) make application to any or either of the Councillors of said Township for exemption in part or in whole and such Councillor is authorized to grant a certificate under his hand which certificate shall within two days be handed by the person so exempted to the Overseer under whose superintendence he was liable to perform such labor & the Overseer shall enter or make the same on his list.
- 4 Be it further enacted that in case any Bridge, causeway or any part of the Highway become broken or damaged by flood or otherwise that they are dangerous or impracticable previous to or after the time allowed by this Big Law for the performance of Statute labor it shall be the duty of the overseer of the Division in which such damages occurs to notify a portion or the whole of the inhabitants to assemble at a certain time and place for the purpose of repairing said damages and the said Overseer shall grant generally to such persons who may so assemble and repair said Damages certificates stating the amount of labor by them respectively performed which certificate on production to such Overseer's successor shall be reckoned by him as the number of days so certified as performed & shall be allowed to those on the next years Statute labor
