- 31 Got a letter from L & P. and a cheque for 139.85 Far took it to Lancaster had it cashed cost 60 cts. Paid Far 25.30 on note 4 for value received - 29.30 - 139.85 = 95

July 28th. It cleared up in the morning and our guests got off. Mrs & John and father called in the morning. Constance Mary was here to dinner. 20 eggs 10. Paid 25 cts to Mr Hewin for steak we got on Wednesday. and 25 for 6 lbs of stew today. Fine day. 20 sugar 25. 12 lbs at John's March 15

- 3 70. Sugar 25. tea 25 60
- 4. I was in church and heard Daniel Scott my off 5 cts
- 5 Gave 2nd to J. 20 cts to Marion 1.20. to Phil Jimmie is on the road today on horseback
- 6 70 3 spools B. thread 12 3 post cards 3 15
- 7. Birdie is not well today. has tonsillitis
- 8 Randy went to the East Front to fish for pike got 4 fine ones. 70 1 bottle Oil 20
- 9 Fierce day. snow all day ground covered
- 10. Baked in oven. The anniversary of our marriage. and I never thought of it until now 9. P.M. 70 1 lb raisin 8.
- 11. Was in church. my & Marion's offer 8 cts
- 12 Washed a few things. snow mostly all off. Jimmie left for North side B. river
- 13 Warm. some rain cleaned the furnace pipes. Pa took ill on Sunday. is better now Birdie is not gaining very fast
- 14 Bright in morning. drizzled in afternoon. Ran went to Lancaster. got 10 20 from M. Dougald paid Sandy 1.50 for over shoes. 75 for rubbers 8.75 for cloth - 11. Paid Frasers 7 for making Suit & furnishing trimming 11.
- 15 Rev A. Givin & A. C. Mc Donnell. paid a pastoral call. Jimmie got home. has finished the assessing.
