here of the Dredge Wanting a  
Man to work cutting with the  
single Mower Made Preserves 17<sup>th</sup>  
Fine John H and Sissy Minnie went to  
Dundee Bought nuts 2 Boxes of Kevener  
1 Box 18 1 Box 20 Cut hair 15 Sastic 15  
2 Pieces of Cotton 20 Put the Power on  
the Barn Thunder Lightning Rain Seander  
went across the Dredge working today  
an Indian here for Butter 18 cents  
18<sup>th</sup> Fine Wind Seander came Received  
a Letter from John Cameron Saw his  
2 Kenees of his Mother and himself and  
some of the Grand Children and his Boy  
Gathering Marsh Hay and Cutting Lewis  
Lasure here Sissy and Minnie to P. Office  
John Hamilton Poorly Seander went  
to Douquets with 10 Dg of Eggs 18 chickens  
Sissy Bought at Haggartys Nutmegs  
and Tea Seander crossed with  
Hyde

James Cameron Island 19<sup>th</sup> August  
John Cameron Birth Day 1870 Fine  
Bismarck Front Marsh Peter  
Cutting in the 7 front Marsh Peter  
Back to 2 lb of Butter 34 20<sup>th</sup> Fine made  
a Stack of the Pease with Marsh hay  
in the Bottom and on Top Made a Stack  
of Marsh hay West of all Eddy Kershaw  
and Sister here Adeline for Buller and  
Eggs 1 Dg 3 lb of Butter 60 Seander went  
for Hyde went around the Island  
The Dredge Working 21<sup>st</sup> Sunday Bill Rose  
Gordon and Spink came The Reverend  
Dr McMillison First preaching  
after being ordained for Salem  
Church Fine Day 22 Fine W Wind  
Seander Stanley John H went to the  
Spy for a Scow to take The Separator  
Down from Uncle Bill's as the Power  
is here took Down 7 at Pine Billy  
is giving the canvass for the Mill  
Lewis 2 children here sent them the 2  
inch auger Gordon went to Cambridge  
Seander to shoes 150 oil 1 gallon
