Fine Wind very Windy went up around the Island 4 Men here of the Dredge Wanting a Man to work cutting with the Single Mower Made preserved 1/7th fine John H. and Sissy Minnie went to Dundee bought nuts 2 Boxes of Keville 1 Boile 18 1 Box 20 cut hair 15 Easter 15 2 Kecks of Cotton 20 Put the power in the Barn Thunder Lightning Rain Leander went across the dredge working today an Indian here for Butter 18 cents 18th fine & Wind Leander came Received a letter from John Cameron Kans his son Kenes of his Mother and himself and some of the grand children and his boy Gathering Marsh Hay and cutting Lewis sawn here Sissy and Minnie to P. O. Office John Hamilton Poorly Leander went to Douquets with 10 Dz of Eggs 18 chickens Sissy bought at Haggartys Nuts and Tea Leander crossed with Heyde

Bismarck cutting in the front Marsh Peter cutting in the back to 2 lbs of Butter 3420^{1/2} fine made a stack of the Pease with Marsh hay in the bottom and on top made a stack of Marsh hay West of all Eddy Renshaw and Sister here Adeline for Butter and Eggs 1 Doz 3 lbs of Butter 60 Leander went for Heyde Went around the Island the dredge working 21st Sunday Bill Rose Gordon and Spunk came The Reverend Mr. McAllister First Preaching after being ordained for Salem church fine day 22 fine Wind Leander Stanley John H. Went to the 8th for a scow to take the separator down from Uncle Bill's as the power is here took down fat Pine Billy 10 3 using the canvas for the mill Lewis 2 children here sent them the 2 inch auger Gordon Went to town a Leander to shoes 150 oil 1 gallon
