Rutting out Manure Ticks Bad 5<sup>th</sup> Cure Mary  
Birth Day cropped Lashey and I never heard of  
Old Mrs Hamiltons Death till I Landed on shore  
Buried to Day went up with Thomas Munroe  
took Dinner there Bought get Mr Harper to plant  
paid - 16 the Semans is all the Salt now 10<sup>th</sup> Sunday  
Walter Baker and his wife came then I cropped over with  
Walter for the 3 children and Mrs Suffield from Below  
Brunstons Place Walter cropped to Thomas Munroe  
11<sup>th</sup> Walter cropped home Lashey cropped to Mr Harper  
have him an Order for 2 Gal oil and 2 lb Tea  
Bought cloth for his coat George came I Planted 1 Bushel  
Potatoes above the corn my own seed R Charles came up went  
to Salmon River to Mr Streeter 5 Bats at 35 cents 1.75  
Calf skin 50 cents Bought get Mr Streeter 1 Pair Lac Boot.  
Bought my own Boots 2 Soled and Foxed 2.50 cents Thomas Munroe  
for Walters Family 3 George sowed the Black Oats  
2 Bushels and 1 peck of Mine I went to Mr Harpers Charles and  
Brought over a Box for a Summer and some for Mr Harper  
some Sweets from Mr Harper for the children 2 pipes  
Charles got his Bottles 14<sup>th</sup> Planting Potatoes in the Beech  
House finished them about 9 1/2 or 10 Bushels of my Potatoes  
and 4 Bushels of Georges in all 15 Sowed his Black Oats near  
the Pond about 1 Bushel and the Rest in White Oats  
Planted in the Potatoes above the House in all about 13 1/2  
Bushels in all of Potatoes Planted Beans abot 4 Quarts and 2 Quarts  
corn I kept his Potatoes and gave him my seed as  
his is larger for eating Lashey to Salmon River with  
Lashey and eels heard of Christopher Prue being  
sent to Penitentiary for stealing a cow from his  
Laird George went home 17<sup>th</sup> Sunday Lashey went for  
Mr H. Basells

18<sup>th</sup> The Memorable Battle of Waterloo Dec  
Raining 15<sup>th</sup> Wilbarr. Lavette fishing with Lashey  
20<sup>th</sup> George came sowing the Oats in the upper field  
8 Bushels of Oats he had altogether and 3 1/2 peck of  
mine of Black Oats George & using the slab fence in  
the Pitt Point 21<sup>st</sup> First hoeing of the Potatoes  
22<sup>nd</sup> Our Dads Birth Day George finished hoeing  
the Potatoes Went home Lashey went to Mr Harper  
Brought me 1/2 lb of Tobacco Mr 23<sup>rd</sup> August came on  
and William Lovellette here sowing Bought a string mill  
Lent him my Laff Garden all weeded for the first time  
cleaning and putting a fence at east and north side of the house  
24<sup>th</sup> Sunday Sun Hopkins here and 2 children and pair  
Done gave the children a little cake of sugar a piece  
25<sup>th</sup> Grew some wood set fire for the ashes firing  
fence on the Pitt Point 26<sup>th</sup> Sowed 1 Bushel of  
Buckwheat George came gave him a harrow took  
for the 1 he last on Lins harrow took home the harrow  
Lashey fishing Bekerel 2 men here to night slept in  
Barn a very Rainy night Thunder and lightning the  
names are Nevins 2 Brothers 1 of them Wounded  
in the mouth, the Back garden Harrowed yet  
nothing in it yet 27<sup>th</sup> Great firing of firs some  
where up the front or on the River Put out the store  
on the 26<sup>th</sup> yesterday 28<sup>th</sup> Lashey to Salmon River with fish  
29<sup>th</sup> Lashey came from Henrys with his salt  
Hap at 2<sup>nd</sup> Bay north side of the Head of the Island  
Put in the single stove drew home the Ashes Mr Frashed  
here Bought the canoe the L Remond Steer  
Commenced to Run here now 1<sup>st</sup> of July Sunday  
to Basells The Ken had 10 chicken 12<sup>th</sup> Tom Darr here  
his hearing Gordon and I for pine around the shore Lashey  
Salmon River Livermore here for fish last night 4<sup>th</sup> Independence  
of the Americans Planted a Row of Potatoes in the old garden  
Bear Paws & Seedlings and Blue Jerseys Raining high  
& using the ashes in the Bay
