Wet, Thursday 31<sup>st</sup> Oct. 1903  
 We chored & wore fence  
 in morning and I plowed  
 near Fords in afternoon  
 with Perrie Plow, put  
 Old Pride of Linemores<sup>2nd</sup>  
 to price of Beuton,  
 got word from G. H. Walter  
 of Kimberly, that he would  
 send pay for bull on 6<sup>th</sup> & 7<sup>th</sup>  
 of Oct.

Friday 2<sup>nd</sup> fine  
 Geo finished weaving fence  
 over to Kammels, and  
 Father & I finished roring  
 rye near Fords.

Saturday, 3<sup>rd</sup> fine  
 Father plowing, Geo Choring  
 & fixing fence, I took  
 Jamie & Mary to Mt Forest  
 went to see W<sup>c</sup> Spears and W<sup>c</sup>  
 Norris. Ticket \$3<sup>00</sup> 3 00  
 Busch ret. 25<sup>00</sup> 25  
 Looked around W. R. Walkers, & Wills  
 Stock looked well, and the folk all  
 look well
