Father Mary & Aunt Jane

Monday 31st June
H.M. 1. We topped turnips and
harrowed out what was
topped on Saturday.
Father took apples
to Cider mill. cost $\$3 \frac{20}{100}$

Tuesday 1st Nov 1904 June
we worked at Turnips
H.M. 1.16 all day got in 16 loads
~~8 loads in morning~~

Wednesday 2nd June
H.M. 1 We worked at Turnips all
day. got root house pretty
well filled & started at
16 pit.

Thursday 3rd June
H.M. 1 Father & I went to vote
in morning then we
brought sheep home
from G.D. R. Station that
Will sent from Mt Forest
8. 4 lambs & 40 sheep
then hauled Turnips in
29⁸ afternoon. 29 small loads
went to down in evening
and heard that H. Guthrie was
elected. Friday 4th June ^{Sundries 05}

We worked at Turnips all
29⁸ day got in 29 small loads

Saturday 5th June
R. H. Harding was here last
night and I took a contract for
1/2 inch space 26 times in advance
for \$20 on conditions that illustration
account is cancelled. We worked
at Turnips all day took in 40
45.8 loads. Tom came for sheep
today
