Fine sunny day cool windy. Willie plowed closer in No 1 for peas then harrowed corn land across both what was sowed and unsowed the latter part I put fertilizer on. We sowed 16 more rows corn ^{Longfellow} coming towards O.S.R. from last rowed. Mary walked down P.M. stayed all night

June 1

Thursday

Fine sunny day cool morning got some warmer by night. We sowed 20 more rows corn coming to O.S.R. Longfellow mixed some last year 4 21 seed in it. We also sowed the peas in same field near road and we planted 5 more rows potato common we also plowed disked and harrowed. A Armstrong in A.M. to see if we could disk his rape land at Abbe 7 of Hamiltons farm. Mary came up ton night got side up with Pellains she spent 6 ds P.O. postage, 45 ds meat Abstruals 5 ds bananas
