- Mon Nov 25. Fine and turning colder. Aunt Matthe and I at Miss Edens in the evening. splendid roads. I called Mrs. McD
- Tue Nov 26. Fine but cold. after heaviest frost of the season. Red Currants
- Wed Nov 27. Fine and milder again. the Furnace out. I called at Mrs Lawrence's she is packing.
- Thur Nov 28. Fine and milder until evening it rained. heavily roads very sloppy. Sorraine here the first since sick
- Fri Nov 29. Strong winds and squalls of rain. Annie here eve.
- Sat Nov 30. Much colder and squalls of snow first of the season then at night it was very rough and snowy. light Furnace again.
