April 1892
W. very fine & clear beautiful spring day
4 Boys sawed wood & drew off roots
& cut feed for F Lewis B went dipping
at Kirkham's this morning I went
to bring him home P.M. he caught 60
suckers & 1 1/2 inch Trout W. Showery
A.M. some slight showers P.M. fall
Went looking very well
5 Boys sawed wood W. warm, very high
W. wind P.M.
6 Boys sawed wood I began plowing
sod at 7 P.M. & H & B helped
Pilkay saw wood P.M. W. fine
I brought Fanny & Baby this
morning she is sewing here today
I went to Whitevale P.M. I came
this evening they staid all night
7 I plowed sod A helped I drew
stons & subberish H & B sawed in
old bush I took Butter & Eggs
to Cuckwells P.M. Butter 20 Eggs 11
W. very fine & clear road getting
8 H & B sawed in old bush letter
I plowed sod W. fine A.M. rain
from about 2 P.M.
9 H & B sawed in old bush A.M.
