& return'd the 27<sup>th</sup>.

27<sup>th</sup>

Election for Assembly for the first Township  
M<sup>r</sup> Sam. Street & M<sup>r</sup> Benj<sup>n</sup> Pauling candidates  
the latter chosen 148 Votes against 48

Sep. 19<sup>th</sup>

A Severe Frost which kill'd my Buck wheat  
before it was ripe, ~~the~~ potatoe vines, & Tobacco

Oct 10<sup>th</sup>

Rec<sup>d</sup>. from Peter Secord Jun<sup>r</sup>. 3 Bushels seed  
Wheat for which I stand indebted

12<sup>d</sup>

Hush'd Corn for Elijah Collard  $\frac{3}{4}$  day work

Oct 1<sup>st</sup>

Corn<sup>o</sup>. Lambert & Elijah Collard 1 day work  
each heaping Logs in My Summer Follow

3<sup>d</sup>

John Collard help me to heap logs in the  
Morning for which I gave him tobacco

10<sup>th</sup>

Sow'd 2 Bushels and 20 Quarts of white Wheat  
on new ground joining the town line that I  
clear'd since harvest, about  $2\frac{1}{2}$  Acres  
Corn<sup>o</sup>. Lambert, Elijah Collard & Rich<sup>d</sup> Harris  
Harrow'd it in 1 day work each

Oct. 22. 1792

To Credit David Secord Sen<sup>r</sup>

25<sup>th</sup> Midlings

Oct. 23. 44<sup>th</sup> do.

Oct 20<sup>th</sup>

Help'd Rich<sup>d</sup> Harris to heap Logs

Oct 26<sup>th</sup>

Finish'd gathering, hushing & storing  
Peter Secord Jun<sup>r</sup>. Corn at his own place  
about 20 Bushels. being his one third share  
with W<sup>m</sup>. Cope for which I am to have  $\frac{1}{2}$

27<sup>th</sup>

Thresh'd my crop of Buck wheat  
about  $1\frac{1}{2}$  Bushels

Nov. 3<sup>d</sup>

Gether'd & hush'd my Crop of Corn had in all  
about 18 Bushels

15<sup>th</sup>

M<sup>r</sup>. Sampson Lutz Mill-dam raised
