Sixie came from Lynn this morning

- April 1 Ad went to Ives sawmill for a load of stuff
- 2 Ad went to Escott with 10 bushel of wheat he bought  
4 bags of hog feed \$1.25 per 100 lbs David & Smittle  
came from Ottawa about 4 o'clock this morning
- 3 Sixie, Vere & Sunset went to Brackville on the  
River David & Smittle went to the River this morning
- 4 Ad went to the 9 conr to see if he could get out rope  
I baled Gap at the house fine day
- 5 rain Ad  
rained this morning & most of the forenoon Ad  
Chopped wood at the house
- 6 The Revd W Toplin preached in the church this evening  
there was heavy thunder & lightning this morning with  
rain & hail this is the first thunder this season
- 7 rain  
drenching rain most of the day David went away  
with Wals horn & Sulphur to Brackville We went on the  
Express
- 8 rain  
rained most of the day Wal came here this morning  
on the Express W<sup>r</sup> Seltie is to meet him here if rain  
sa that they did not get to Escott
- 9 Ad went to the 9 conr to see if he could get  
out rope, came home at noon could do nothing  
Henry Folly came to work at noon Ad has  
hired him for six months at 20 d. Hereo per  
month & 18 for the rest of the time till he comes  
from Red River he is gone there <sup>heavy rain & night</sup> with his Brothers
- 10 Henry is Chopping wood at the house Ad went out  
with W Walsh to look for dry cattle fine day
- 11 Ad went to Rockport to get water proof boots
- 12 Ad got home this afternoon Henry is Chopping  
wood at the house I went round the out side fence
- 13 The Revd W Toplin preached in the church this morning
- 14 Ad went to Bonanogue in the Buggy Tennet went  
with him Henry finished cutting the wood off <sup>cut off part</sup>  
more the fence along the road & put it in a line  
of the church field leaving <sup>an</sup> <sup>opening</sup> <sup>in</sup> a road  
around the Shoalhouse the church
- 15 Henry scraped up the dung in the Barn gave in the  
pioneer boxed part of the fence with mule packs
