 Raining in A.M. cloudy most day some Sunshine P.M. We cleaned other barn floor and relaid some of it A.M. P.M. forked over hay in new orchard waled it up in evening also S.D. raked in No 6. Wallic took Fama to Allan's Girls down town P.M. got at Walls meat 45 cts Phillips Sundries 30 cts. got P.O. cashed for Phillips butter got several weeks ago \$4.32 at Russells goods \$3.22 (Expense 30) (paid with due bills) at Steels good 2.92 chrgd at Armstrongs flour & groceries \$4.42 chrgd. Young Richardson Chapman & Wansborough up in evening for figs got one 5 cts. Girls up at James Skeels in evening with Lucy. We got considerable hay spoiled with rain lately
