- 19 Pretty fine day got Willie Goodan to buy high wines for Pa. 25 cts Dr Falkner was in twice to see Pa 25
- 20 1 box soda crackers 25. 1 pair rubbers for Murdy Pa is not improving any. Auntie is not so well today Marion is up today. Jimmie is not keeping very well. his grippe will have to run its course 85
- 21 Snow and rain got  $\frac{1}{2}$  gill coal oil 13 cts gave Murdy & Ran each 10 cts 15
- 22 Sold 2 doz eggs. got 1 lb soda  $\frac{1}{4}$  lb blue 20
