Very stormy day especially in P M strong east wind snowing, hailing at night. I took load manure to T. L. field and brought up load wood from bush in P M we cut up all small stuff of load with axe on block of wood.

Terribly stormy last night east wind turned to rain soft all day frost again by evening. I took down 8 hogs sold to Scheris Sept 26 they weighed 1210 at \$4.65 per cut 56²⁵ weight¹⁴ I took 11 bags pig chop 1505 lbs to Curless and brought up load manure from Steels spread it on fall wheat. Mary and Martha Cowley collecting for B. Society in P M Mother up in P M. I got at Woods 2 undents 2.00 lining 21 postage 8cts
