- 10 Mrs Rodrick 42 days. Put at Fair 1 lb 8. tea 25. 1/2 lb tea 45  
1 lb starch 8. 1 spool 5. 1 lb soda 5. 1 packet onions 23  
Pa went to Cornwall.
- 11 Fine cool day
- 12 I did not write any thing for my work was tied up Pa took it to Lancaster thinking to use it at the coast in his suit with W. Kilford, he did not use it  
On the 18<sup>th</sup> had Mrs Rodrick home day there was a big rain storm had her 2 hours on the 20<sup>th</sup> dressing hers 2 hours on Saturday mopping.  
Got sugar 30<sup>cts</sup> loaf 1.10 bread 45 1 lb tea 25  
40 + 1.10 + 45 + 25 = 2.20

24. Uncle Sandy came on the 21<sup>st</sup> J. Brown went to the Green Valley for him and drove him there yesterday, Jimmie went on the 18<sup>th</sup> to Kingsley came home on the 21<sup>st</sup> to attend the games on the 22. he went back on the 24 Murdy left on the 24<sup>th</sup> for Toronto Anne Fran McL was here Saturday Sunday until Monday morning. She left for Cornwall. Far was home on Saturday. On Saturday night there was a wild storm of rain thunder and lightning 12 all cent on Uncle Sandy Papa and I were at J. L spending the evening. we met Mr & Mrs Guin. There was an address in our church last night by Mrs Murdoch McKingie. she gave a short account of her leaving Miss. and she traveled so they under went Marion taught for Birdie today. The entrance exams began today, very hot mercury 91
