- Thur Aug 30. Fine and cool. Men over at Willies
- Fri Aug 31. Fine and cool, finished grain at Willies. I walked out to Thornhill in the afternoon.
- Sat Sept 1. Fine and cool. Men all here. Sam left at noon. John Troyer here for dinner. Sizzie and Annie Mason here for tea. Finished grain. made catsup
- Sun Sept 2. Rained in the afternoon. Uncle and Aunt Mattie at Mr Gallanough's funeral. I went to Fisherville. It is very, very warm. Uncle and Aunt Nellie at re. ch.
- Mon Sept 3. Fine and cool. Willie here helping to pull peas.
- Tues Sept 4. Fine and cool. Auntie and I up at Mary's in the evening. but she was not at home.
- Wed Sept 5. Fine day. Aunties at the Exhibition. beautiful day. our men over hauling peas and ratings at Willies Annie here for tea. Apollas left.
