 Snowed Drifted 30<sup>th</sup> Stormy  
 Turned Fine Big snow Drifts  
 Fused the Pipes took up  
 water sent a letter to the  
 Glengarran with a Dollar in  
 it got from Gordon on the 29<sup>th</sup>  
 31<sup>st</sup> Fine Drifting Broke on a  
 Fine Hay Stack  
 Lewis wife a young son about  
 the 29<sup>th</sup>
