Mon Feb 21<sup>st</sup> clear and cool. the sharpest frost last night that has come this fall. Sarah was here this after noon

Tue Feb 22<sup>nd</sup> clear and cool. Walter came in this morning. Sarah came for the dirty cloaths. I cleaned the cook stove

Wed Feb 23<sup>rd</sup> light clouds drifting through the sky a cool day Sarah came over this after noon to help me to clean and put up the stove pipe

Thu Feb 25<sup>th</sup> clear and cool the hardest frost last night yet this fall

Fri Feb 26<sup>th</sup> clear and warm in the fore noon wind came from the after noon and cool. Charley and Otta Bolton came in this after noon

Sat Feb 27<sup>th</sup> clear in the fore noon after noon cloudy and cool. Sarah was here and Bilton was this after noon

Sun Feb 28<sup>th</sup> cloudy and wet heavy rain last night. Sarah came over with my clean cloaths

Mon Feb 29<sup>th</sup> cloudy and misting rain part of the after noon. Walter was in for the key

Tue Feb 30<sup>th</sup> clear fore part of the day. latter part cloudy a sharp frost last night

Wed Feb 31<sup>st</sup> clear most of the day. Sarah came over this morning.

Thu Nov 1<sup>st</sup> light clouds moderate Bilton called this morning and Sarah. William McIntosh this after noon to get the use of my corn crib.
