

WEDNESDAY, APRIL 17, 1872.

Weather cool but thawing. Ice failing - no mail today.

Friday April 14th 1872

Cold again today, no thaw, nor any appearance of milder weather. I feel very nervous today having slept none all night, although I had no pain or trouble of any account. Stephen Lywell taken very ill apparently influenza or what the doctors pronounce Neuralgia of the Muscles.

Saturday April 15th

Still clear and cold, enjoyed good rest last night and head becoming all the time more cool & settled.

Sunday April 16th

Clear and cold, sleighs trying to run on what is rather slickening now Wagoning. our Village Street now perfectly dry
