8 Sandy Stewart & Wife came on a visit & to see the Baby

9 underbrushed a little rained in the forenoon fair &  
fine in the afternoon went to in the Swamp

10 worked in the Swamp in the forenoon drew in  
the Rye in the afternoon John Claw & Wife  
here on a visit & to see Rabson

11 drew stones from the gangway of the old Barn  
to the deck between the garden & the Barn

12 went to Cauntown & heard the Revd Mr McKinnon preach

13 rained all day Thomas Scott & Wife here all day to  
see Jocks Baby he is very bad David went to Farmers  
ville with Nat & bought a sheepskin from Kincaid  
to matten to bind with
