- Wed Jan 9. Fine but cold and windy. I was at Mrs Peckles in eve. Carnival.
- Thur Jan 10. Fine but cold. Sorraime here for dinner.
- Fri Jan 11. Fine and moderately warm. I was at H. Bowers butchering.
- Sat Jan 12. A. dreadful storm, all day, did not go out all day. not even dig tracks
