Received Paid

July 12 continued Wednesday forward
and a little in P.M. warm. We bagged
up 74 $\frac{1}{4}$ bushels oats fanned some of them
and Willie took them down to Currier in
P.M. @ 43cts bushel received on them 31.80
I cut wood mended side delivery rake and etc.
Willie brought up load manure from Smalls.

Thursday

W am day thunder clouds forming in AM
heavy shower at noon some rain in P.M.
Willie, Tom Ford and I at turnips in AM
Willie scuffled some. Willie went down
for mother in buggy paid Armstrong for turnips
got 11th 15.00 of bag shots 1²⁵ gooseberries 25
then came back finished scuffling turnips
and scuffled some potatoes. Tom & I had turnips

heavy about noon cleared off in P.M.
Tom and I thinned turnips today.

Willie finished scuffling potatoes. In P.M.
Willie went down in buggy got at Meekins
5 lbs copperas 40 lbs paris green 20 paid W. Danett
dash board etc \$1.30 paid Charlie Gross for cycle
sharpener \$650 Father came up with him
they brought up the two hifers that were pasture
down there. We put paris green and
Bordeaux mixture combined on potatoes
at night. The girls down at Dennis at night
