^{Saturday} Oct. 24, 1891. Started for the Back Woods on a Deer hunting expedition.
^{Sunday} " 25. Arrived at our camping ground.

^{Monday} " 26. Shot my first Deer on Stony Lake.

^{Wednesday} " 28. Shot my second Deer on Stony Lake.

^{Sunday} Nov. 1. Started for home having bagged five Deer. Messrs. John & Myer Warner and myself comprised the hunting party.

The year 1891, as near as I can remember was as follows, Winter, considerable snow and many Fairs, Spring was early, Summer was quite warm, with much lightning Thunder & Rain, Fall was unusually fine and warm perpetual sunshine till about the 20th of Nov. Then we had a very rainy season till Jan^y 1892,

^{Friday} Dec 25. Beginning Christmas Day. A dull cloudy and misty day.

Spent the day at A. Brown's Moscow. The party included Mrs Warner, Melissa Warner, Augusta Warner, Iola Warner, and myself. We drove home at night through a dense fog.

^{Saturday} " 26. Raining in the forenoon turning a little colder towards evening with high winds from the west.

^{Sunday} " 27. Cold and partly cloudy.

^{Monday} " 28. Cold and clear, wrote to M. F. M. for Pitt. Ans.

^{Tuesday} " 29. Cloudy and windy, commenced raining at noon, turning to snow. Stopped to rain at night.
