W. W. Cameron Island March 11
 Cold & Wind a Sleigh with one Horse crossed to Frasers
 on the South Side passed the Foot of the Island
 and came Back Drawing Wood 12" On this
 Day of March Dr. B. & M. & W. & S. first
 came to the Island Cold and Fine a Buggy
 went up one Driving and 2 Men trying the
 ice and a Dog along with them the Buggy came
 Back and crossed at the Head of the Island on
 the Road where they Landed on either side
 I got out Snow 13" & Wind Drew some Firewood to
 the Camps (Mantle) and I saw Birds nor Ducks
 though the ice opened so early very frosty time this
 is the earliest it ever opened here But food you
 outside of the holes a Sleigh one Horse and Indian
 came down the ice crossed at the Foot of the Island
 got a Squirrel in the trap set for mink a good
 Lot of Travelling on the Lancaster Road 14 Sunday
 Cold in Morning the Buggy Born Stanley
 & Wind 15" Fishing 2 lbs got 1 Bar for the Hunt
 16" & Wind. Morning Fine turned stormy & crossed a Ice
 and Tom Frasher crossed at the Head of the Island when
 crossed in the morning all broke up I have
 some are up Bought of Mr Ward 1 lb Tea 60 lb of
 Soda 10 Castor oil 10 Phil 25 Soap 2 Bars one 7 and
 the other 4 on credit Jan paid Matches 5 Met Tom Frasher
 and made him so Between the gulches ice bad
 17th St Patrick's Day Janet & M. & J. & W.
 Departed Dan Mc Gregor and Bill
 Holesworth here sold Maud 20 Sold a Cow
 14 Dollars 34 Dollars for the 2 went up as for John
 Hannellous John sold a cow a Fine Day
 got 20 Dollars and John Hannellous will
 let the Rest as he is going up 18th crossed Got 14
 Dollars from John H. Bought of Mr Ward 1 lb of
 Tea 60 lb of Soap other Pins & sweeten. Felled up to
 and all I owe him to day
 continued.

 exchanged my Paul gave Gordon 17 cents
 Donald Cameron (Barby) Mr Ward at carnival
 3rd Janet & M. & W. & S. returned to day
 drew some Wood a Fine Day (Mantle) 14
 Sept 7 Trees 20th first Day of Spring Fine
 snowed some heard Wild Geese yesterday
 I drew Grant here with an account
 of 3" 33 cents But Sam a gunner he owes
 me drew some stones to the wharf took
 some of the Sugar Bush (Mantle) to
 the Bush Sept 9 Trees 20th the Gunner
 Fine snowed some 2 W and South West
 21st (Mantle) Sunday Fine W Wind spanner crossing
 on the ice crossed above the Head of
 the Island came down the River 22nd (Mantle)
 Birth Day a very fine Day Drawing Firewood
 took home 3 loads of saw 23rd & Wind Fine turned
 stormy very large flakes of snow coming down
 heavy cutting stove Wood ice opening some
 24th cleaned the double barreled Gun & chopping
 stove Wood 25th Unannounced began drawing
 stove Wood W Wind Blustery 26th John H. 13 Day
 good Friday draws a very fine Day W Wind
 Fishing 2 lbs lost the line in one of the 2 holes
 drew some wood a Fine Day 27th (Mantle) Sept 2
 some some wood here 27th some ice was high
 some of the jammed ice going down not
 opening well with hurt tracks very next
 28th Easter Sunday the Sun but not a trace
 this morning but a fine Day 29th Gordon
 came to help Sept to day 30th (Mantle) some
 gallons of Syrup 1st of (Mantle) all (Mantle)
 (Mantle) crossed Bought of Mr Ward (Mantle) 1 lb of
 31st St Bathusee & 2 Boys in Sugar Bush took (Mantle)
 at Head of the Island Got a fine Saw from Jan
