Willie took 1340 lbs pig chop barley and oats mixed equal parts to Wilsons 67 lbs got barrel of flour at Nichols & its grapes at Armstrongs \$1 brought up from Armstrongs on a/c ton shorts \$25.00 took 16 more cabbage to Carton to make the 3 day on Saturday night trade \$1.30 got oatmeal to balance grain \$1.50 paid Hodge on full shoeing Oct 4th and 16 85cts In PM Willie plowed No 2 N E in 2 M worked at S drain got some more tile laid. Mr Gass over in evening lent him Westminsters Silver maple.

Saturday

Fine day sunny, hard frost last night. Willie plowed 5 horses No 2 N E in 2 M I painted kitchen. In PM we hauled in 4 loads turnips we had trimmed on 17th then I painted and Willie plowed No 2 2 horses. In morning I plowed up Mr Gass' drill potatoes and he picked them 27 bushels before us 15 We sent him Nellie in light wagon to take his home etc. Willie down town at night Paid Armstrongs a/c to date \$42.00 got at McDermott's traps 10 tugs and 5 gloves 30
