October 18 continued Friday Forward 21 61 58 1384 77

Willie took 1340 lbs pig chop barley and oats mixed equal parts to Wilsons 67 etc got bolted for plow at Nichols 8 etc grapes at Armstrongs 50 brought up from Armstrongs in afternoon shorts \$25.⁰⁰ took 16 more cabbage to Canton to make the 5 day on Saturday night trade \$1.30 got out of balance groceries \$1.50 paid Hodge in full shoeing Oct 4th and 16 85 etc In P M Willie plowed No 2 N two horses, I worked at I drain got some more tile laid. Mr Gess over in evening lent him Westminster Silver maple.

Fine day sunny, hard frost last night. Willie plowed 5 horses No 2 NE in A M I painted kitchen. In P M we hauled in 4 loads turps we had trimmed on 17th then I painted and Willie plowed No 2 2 horses. In morning I plowed up Mr Gess' drill potatoes and he picked them 27 bushels he gave us 15- We lent him Nellie in light wagon to take his home etc. Willie down town at night Paid Armstrongs' a/c to date \$42.00 got at Mc Dermotts snaps 10 tug and 5 gloves 30
