rowing got a Lunge 20<sup>th</sup> Last Day of Spring  
one Fernandez went to Dundee Some came  
home from Dundee Windy squally Day  
Prasers Son here stopt in the Bay  
it got squally Gordon working at his  
Boat Peter Back near Bright Biller  
the Syrup 1 Quart 69 cents cutting grass  
for the Bull Livina not very well 1<sup>st</sup>  
of Day Summer Fine West Wind  
cutting brush on the north side heavy Rain  
Livina not well Fernandez and Stanley  
went for a Stick of Lumber to Lewis  
2<sup>nd</sup> Our Dan's Birth Day Uncle Dan  
Fine Heavy Rain Thunder very high Wind  
the Big American Boat in Pieces on  
Pontoons went Down 2 or 3 Pugs a  
rowing her Livina very unwell Gordon  
painting his Boat 3 Men here Bought  
John H's Fish Fernandez went to  
Ancester
