Kate & the Glor kids in the evening. Mary was gone in day at Jernies until Monday (Allens wife had a baby girl) Sun 22 Glor went home. The youngsters went to Sunday with the girls they sang a piece they all walked. Will & I went to Readleys Arthur kept house Paul brought the cows & milked the youngsters got home in late they guarded the cows for a little while after they were milked

Fri 23. They raked the oats. Tom Readley after Paul he won Arthur stayed tonight.

after dinner they drew the oats & made the stack. I churned

Yea 24 Will & Arthur went to Drummondville took 4 lbs of butter

1/2 dog eggs 11 lbs butter 113. 2 loaves bread 12 sack flour 8.5

lb short 17 Tangle foot 5 butter paper 4. 50 lbs molasses 6.3 he had the last of his oats. The threshing machine he com

Wed 25 when they went to thresh they found the engine leaking had to go to Drem to get it fixed lost all the afternoon started after dinner finished over there & the oats here. I cleaned the oat bin out fixed the floor yesterday

Thur 26 threshed out the wheat here. I churned. Fannie went Arthur & Ruth to the League entertainment tonight. it was grand & the meal was grand. I washed out the white clothes boiled them

put them to soak over night - carried most of the water from the creek to wash set sponge tonight Fannie stayed Friday 27. I cooked the bread carried more water to wash for

not to take the rain water put the white clothes out & washed the colored clothes & starched a lot of things besides doing the work. milking & separating the milk it just about kills me when they are tired. Gordon went after the rooster at Wallace Marjorie guarded the cows while he went to town for the boy

Sat 28 I swept the house all over cleaned both rooms swept the yard cleaned all the boards. made 3 pies ginger cake & ginger cookies dried the hen she had hung down with fat & craned a lot after dark. The youngsters went to Kipliques after pears. Fannie here. a thunder storm about 12 & such a beautiful rain

I dusted the front room & dining room after the children went to bed Fannie did not come until late. Fannie & her mother

Sun 29 beautiful after rain went to Chippawa took 5 lbs butter they made at 5 lbs of 25 pds - 12.7. 1/2 dog eggs & 24 16.3 - 8 lbs gran sugar 3 lbs brown sugar 5 nails 4 peast 6 cornmeal 10. nutmegs 4

Sun 29. to beautiful after the rain turns cool in the after noon the children went to church. the minister in Will Pells. Hallie & Arthur went to the brick Fannie went to Argyle Paul came from Readley stayed to dinner went right after dinner
