I put it on the fire & baked it while she was guarding the cows at night. I washed the kens off the oats.  
Friday I finished the pig pen at last Paul nailed down the second floor after I sawed them then Arthur came over & helped put them on the pen. Marjorie getting ready to start in Pelham Paul said Mrs Reef & Flor was coming so I made peach cake a sponge cake & a custard pie & they never intended to come. Marjorie gave up going until morning then Hattie says she will drive her down (she took 3 doz eggs & going to get the groceries with her money. got meat & livers. cheese 1/2 tea sugar) Paul went down to see about his watch he sent up a tin bologna I made 2 custard pies & a ginger cake & churned & cleaned the room. Kate & the Flor kids in the evening. Mary was gone in stay at farmer's until Monday (Allen's wife had a baby)  
Sun 22 Flor went home. the youngsters went in Sunday with the girls they sang a piece they all walked. Will & Lill went in Reauleys Arthur kept house Paul brought the cows & milked the youngsters got home so late they guarded the cows for a little while after they were milked.  
Mon 23. they raked the oats. Tom Reauley after Paul he went after dinner they drewed the oats & made the stack. I churned  
Tues 24 Will & Hattie went in Drummondville took 4 1/5 of butter 12 doz eggs 11 1/2 butter 113. 2 loaves bread 12 sack flour 85 lb dard 17 tangle foot 5 butter paper 4. 50 lbs middlings 63 he had the last of his oats. The threshing machine he came brought Mary Reexmeyer over after a spool of thread

Wed 25 when they went in thresh they found the engine leaking had to go in 10 am to get it fixed lost all the forenoon started after dinner finished over there & the oats here. I cleaned the oat bin out & fixed the floor yesterday.  
Thurs 26 threshed out the wheel here. I churned. Fannie went in the League Entertainment bought. it was grand & the night was grand. I washed out the white clothes boiled them put them in soak over night - carried most of the water from the creek in wash tub - sponge brought Fannie stayed  
Friday 27. I mixed the bread carried more water to wash so not to take the rain water put the white clothes out & washed the colored clothes & starched a lot of things besides doing the work. milking & separating the milk it just about kills me when they are tired. Gordon went after the rooster at Wallace's Marjorie guarded the cows while he went - 40¢ for the Pig  
Sat 28 I swept the house all over cleaned both rooms swept the yard cleaned all the boards. made 3 pies ginger cake & ginger cookies dressed the hen that hung down with fat & croned a lot after dark. the youngsters went in Montagues after pears. Fannie dark. a thunder storm about 12 & such a beautiful rain here. I dusted the front room & dining room after the children went in bed Fannie did not come until late. Fannie & her mother  
Sun 29 beautiful after rain went in Chippawa took 5 1/2 butter they made it 58 1/2 of 25 per lb - 127. 1 1/2 doz eggs @ 24 1/63 - 8100 gram sugar 33 brown sugar soap 5 nails 4 yeast 5 commenced 10. nutmegs 4  
Mon 29. so beautiful after the rain. Fannie cool in the after noon the children went in church. she married in Hall. Fannie & Arthur went in the brick Fannie went in. Lill & Paul came from Reauleys stayed in dinner went right after dinner
