August Monday 23 1926

All of us except "Katie" our cook slept in until quarter to six so I was late getting away to Paris. Mr and Mrs. Birley arrived home at noon from Beaumont after a nice trip. Retired early at night after a busy day.

Tuesday 24  
Carl and Clara, Johnny and Marge, Mel and Betty, Alice and Roscoe, Orval and Helen, and Jean and I attended a dance at Mohawk Park and had a wonderful time. I had some of the best dances I ever had. We drove the two Fords and I acted as chauffeur of the "sedan". Home at 11:0 P.M.
