(186-180)

It was quite warm I fixed the pig yard Archie and Bell went out front the local smashed a gigger it rained a fine shower. 1918.5 we worked at the

(187-179)

It was a little wet in the morning Abbie was here for dinner we took the milk wagon and all went up to our day school and preaching Daniel and Margary was here for tea.
