Expenses fare 40 admittance 25 dinner 20 Separation fare 75 Jim 10. I drove Mary down town in P.M. got at W. vels 5 yds flannel \$1.40 per 4 striking 50 at Phillips vasaline 5 at tarton 10 cordage 10 soap 5. at Fouts sugar 25 ginger 5 yeast cake 5 paid with eggs. Even at Armstrongs 20 Coll W. F. M. S. 5 Paid Thompson \$1.65 for paper got in spring. Received from Mrs M. V. ian for butter 4.35
