at Lewis's fishing Eels Sunday  
John H. Went to Hammonds for  
the Mail and was the first  
we heard of John Angus  
death and then we segnit on  
the Glengarnan departed on  
New Years eve the 31<sup>st</sup> Decem<sup>ber</sup>  
1890 Buried at 2 o'clock Friday  
the 2<sup>nd</sup> 1891 his ailment was  
inflammation of the Lungs 4<sup>th</sup>  
The 2 girls went over to Lewis's  
Lewis came over with them to  
see me had 2 axe handles  
Gave him new years to take  
to the children ~~5<sup>th</sup> Jan 1891~~  
~~Birth DAY~~ 5<sup>th</sup> Sept 1850  
Age 40 years (his Birth Day) 3 Months & 26 Days
