Lime Salts for Filling Bone Cavities.

Marcozzi recommends a mixture of equal parts of calcium phosphate and carbonate for filling bone cavities. This is easily sterilized, easily handled, and when applied to the bleeding surfaces after curettage exerts a strong hemostatic effect. It is superior to other filling material in that it consists of substances closely related to osseous tissue and stimulating osteogenesis. The lime salts are gradually and completely absorbed and replaced by new bone, this occurring within a period of thirty to forty days.—*Rif. Med.*
