THURSDAY 10

1876

Heavy Windy Storm tonight

Go to Haverhill at 8 + stay all day
Begin putting in Extract the
Bee. Mills hauls it over,
but telegram from Parsons
that he will be over this day
train, I make out a full quantity
of leaf sold for past 2 years +
make out profit on same.
The 1st year in average 31 Hides
per unit at 37^{1/2} pH
2nd year 50 Hides per unit at 34

Met CP at train we sit & talk
till 12^{1/2}. I show him Rutledge's
mistake of \$91,000. CP tells me
they put price of leaf down to
3^{1/2} Hides to 30 + sold to J. D.
Campbell when they last met at 2nd Wash
9th. Sale whole by from Washington
