Shores came Planted Corn Facing the Fence 8<sup>th</sup>  
Henry Bosell aged Anteyones wife and  
children here E. Wind Fine 5<sup>th</sup> Randolph  
crossed with a pair of the Boots I  
took from Mr. Woods Thunder some Rain  
Windy Fencing the calves Pasture Fence  
16<sup>th</sup> Working at the Grove 11<sup>th</sup> Mr. Burdell  
here came to Henrys last night working  
at Fence Randolph hit some of those weeds  
that Blows out of the Bottom of the River  
on the Potato ground gave three men  
50 cents to take up Bread from Montreal  
Charing their Sturgeon got the huzzard  
from them they pay its food eating  
12<sup>th</sup> Ploughing the Back piece Harrowing the  
Bean Place 13<sup>th</sup> Harrowing (cutting up) Fence  
Went to the Hit-Hit for the (Barn & Home  
Day) the Passport went Down  
12<sup>th</sup> Planted the Californias Potatoes or what  
they call Med hinistes or some name like  
that at the Barn a ellan up from  
Valley field slept on the Bank  
he is Buying Cordwood, went to Christmas  
Island and Na - Frontas Island Shora took  
4 Loaves of a Peice from Montreal 25 cents  
Lots of Boats a going now all day, intoes Bar  
Making a smudge for them every night  
E Wind Rained Heavy to night Thunder  
Ducks Plenty Loons Gulls Wild Geese yet  
Oriole came this week 15<sup>th</sup> Windy 16<sup>th</sup> E W Wind  
Princip Louisa ground at the Mouth of Salmon River  
17<sup>th</sup> E Wind High 18<sup>th</sup> Making Fence to scow here  
for sand from Lancaster got 2 Dollars  
from them and Promised me another  
19<sup>th</sup> Fencing the Fence on the Pitt Point  
20<sup>th</sup> Planted the garden Back of the house  
with Potatoes

Mr James Cameron, Island 27<sup>th</sup> July 1881

went to Summerstown John Hamilton up with us  
Bought of Mr Ward 25 lb of Flour 8 1/2 Salt 15

Pan of Bread 24 Corinthian went down  
22<sup>nd</sup> Rogation Sunday Angus Cameron and wife

and 2 Boys and the hirl Had a loaf of Bread  
23<sup>rd</sup> Went to Na-Houtas Island I heard the

2 sheep a very warm Day Let the Horse  
out oiled him on account of the Grease

24<sup>th</sup> The Misses Birth Day Let out the  
3 calves to Pasture Firing some good holes

Cutting Weeds in the Potatoes 25<sup>th</sup> Cleaned  
the Weeds in the Corn and Hoerget

the Well Gene here him and Johnny  
26<sup>th</sup> I brought me a Bag of Potatoes  
gave him a stick for Spear Pole

Planting Manure on the Potatoes and  
on the Hay a fine Day 27<sup>th</sup> Cropped to

Summerstown Bought of Mr Ward 25 lb of  
Flour 65 2 lb of Tea 30 got a Bag of Potatoes

at Flannaltas 50 lb of 4 Shur all  
settled 35 cents a Bushel for Potatoes

31 Bushel got John Pointing the  
Lighthouse seen Margaret Rose a Bag

Flight at Nicholson's (Beady Matty and  
Friday 28<sup>th</sup> Hoing and cutting Weeds  
Snow comes in at night Fine & Windy

Had eating the Potatoes trimmed the cherry  
trees 29<sup>th</sup> Hoyle Oak Day or oak Apple

30<sup>th</sup> Windy Hoing Angus Cameron down to  
the Fisherman to Buy Fish got a

Surgeon and 3 Rishes over 40 cents  
On the fish got 50 cents from the Fisherman  
Bought 2 lb of Butter 5 cents 30<sup>th</sup> Hoing

31<sup>st</sup> Hopkins Charlie and Johnny here with  
the Big Boat they found
