Mumma Burkholder to dinner & to Doc
Burkholder to supper (that is David
son he lives with them) Henry Adeline
& Anne were in Meeting too W. very fine

24 A ^{to} Henry spouted & bagged 18
bag Potatoes I scuffled some Mangel
A M I went to Cedar Grove A M
W. Clear & warm A Shank was
here to dinner he Reddler small white

25 A & Henry mowed some Sweet
hay on the Jacob Reesor farm Thomas
gave it to us. A M they bagged 2 more
bags of Potatoes & cut some
we killed 2 Pigs after sup for
Mamie Bonnie & got her shoot on hind
feet I went along as far as P. D. is
to fish but they did not bite W. very

26 Henry cut thistles in pasture I went
to see Carpenter to come to Flewin to
fix granary then he scuffled Potatoes
till noon I Chord & turned hay at
Covey's P M A went to Smith 20
bag Potatoes @ 30. per bag 2 Pigs 129

27 A wife were here to supper. W. very warm
I & Henry worked at Flewin laying mow floor
W. very warm
Thomas & Anne Diller came
home from Missouri today at noon
