Sunday A Fortunate Day Raining Rained hard
Last night East Wind cloudy with smoke from Fires
Bacon and 2 Woman here to 7 $\frac{3}{4}$ lbs of Butter
and 6 Quarts of Milk 2 Dollars Told us about
Goselas Death in Dundee 29th Fine Mowing
making coils Miss Harkness and Barton Cameron
here The Dredge to 7 lbs of Butter 140 ice 40
6 Doz of Eggs 72 That's 2.52 Few Drops of Rain
Splitting Cedar for Rails at the New Potatoes
Miss Harkness and the Rest of Them are out
on a Time it Rained to night most awful
heavy a continued Down pore put in the Horses
as they find the way of coming in at night
30th Dull Turned very Fine Set the Water Run in
the yard as there is a Deep hole and the Rain
so Heavy Last night Filled it a Fine Day Doing
nothing West Wind a Lot of Bouts Passed to
Day Miss Webster to (nothing) and ice 5 cents Seander
crossed got an almanack from the Ramsay
Weekly Journal 31st Fine West Wind Last
Day of July Began a Fine Hay Stack got
2 Loads in it when it commenced to Rain
and Dropt it George Jimmy and Lavinia Sen
came Thunder and Lightning Bought 8, 11 cent
worth 2 lbs of Butter 12, 52 7 mm
the Miss Webster George and Jimmy went off
1st of August Lammias Day Fine Cool W Wind
Taking away stones from around the House
cut some stove wood The Dredge to 7 lbs Butter 140
6 Doz of Eggs 72 paid up to this Date 7.32 Got
Ice to Begin with 40 cents Brought to Douglas
1 Tub of Butter and 8 Cans of Syrup

Minnie's Birth Day 1864-37 years A very Fine Day
Websters to 3 lbs of Butter 60 3 Doz of Eggs 36 12 Quarts of Cream 25
That's 1.21 paid ice not paid very warm at the Stack
~~For Butter 3 lbs 60 3 Doz Eggs 36 12 Quarts Cream 25~~
Put a Top on the Stack as it looks like Rain Rained
to night 3rd Raining this Morning Fine Day
Taking off Stones putting them on the Bank
2 girls and 2 Boys here For Butter 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ lbs 50 Peter Back
to 2 lbs 36 Gordon took Down Mr Alexander Hall and
Mrs Hall and Maudie all of Cornwall Bacon and
Wife here 2 lbs of Butter 40 2 Quarts of Milk 10 Silby-
Renshaw for Stanley to put in Hay stoft all
night 4th Sunday in Hall and Seander to church
Adelaide the Boy and Minnie came Down with
them Seander went up with them 5th Dredge
6 Doz of Eggs 72 Ice 40 Websters ice 5 cutting
the Wheat on the South side Eddy Stanley Seander
went to Corvington and Dundee 3 Jennels or Tubs
Jar of oil That's all I see any thing else they
Dont Tell Frank Lemay to 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ lbs of Butter 50
Jacob, Janagoras. Sock. here got salt
6th Randolph's Birth Day 1867. 34 years
East Wind Killed a Mutton Fishing got 15 here
in the Forenoon got 12 in the afternoon the 2 girls
Went to Summerstown The Dredge settled all
up to this Date 1.92 Jesse came with
the 2 girls Bought a Washboard 25 cents Dredge
Left went above Summerstown Rained to night
very hard 7th a Fortunate Day Rained this
Morning Seander to Summerstown again him
and Jesse and Minnie crossed to Summerstown
Turned Fine Webster for ice 3 Doz of Eggs 76 Jesse
and Tonia Fishing caught 2 Rock Bass The
Lamb Disappeared not here in the Morning
