at night. Election day for Ontario House  
Willie and I drove to Cambridge after dinner voted

breakfast on barn floor it was moist and  
heating. Dave Allan in to see about getting potatoes.  
Willie took the chop down P.M. 1298 lbs to  
Wilson's 65 took Kate's tool Armstrong's Prince Alexander  
Willie down town at night hand that of Grayman's dietary content.

at \$1.30. I met Jim Lunn at Guelph.
