Willie plowed No 2 A M. I put up chop spread breakfast on barn floor it was musty and heating. Dave Allen in to see about getting potatoes. Willie took the chop down P M 12 98 lbs to Wilsons 65 took Kate's food Armstrong's fine Alexander Willie down town at night heard that J Gray was in doctor's post.

Fine sunny day cloudy at times. Dave Allen came for potatoes in morning 17 1/2 bags at 70 cts \$12.60 paid him for cow \$1.00. Willie plowed and harrowed in No 2 to day. He drove me to station in morning enroute to Guelph express to Model Farm fare 50 street car 15 cts and for separator and ball 10 cts. I took book (Broom) to Mrs Lunn got dinner at Farm came back night. My home town got at Mills meat 30 at Phillips goods 20 Hals shoes 10 Mamma's paints brushes etc \$1.30. I met Jim Lunn at Guelph.
