Monday 20th.

Tom came to cut fall
wheat. Started to cut
about 11 a.m. and
had to stop about 6:30
P.M. on account of
heavy shower. Jno. went
to Russell's in Tom's place.

Tuesday 21st.

Tom came in morning
and finished cutting
fall wheat about 5 P.M.
Grandpa, Jno. & Geo. were
shocking up.
