- 18 Fine bright day, 7/8 codfish 35<sup>th</sup> 2 loaves 12  
6 cakes of Compost soap 25
- 19 Fine bright day Jimmie's birthday, Murdy went to Glen Donald to see the owners of the land where the Rail Road may pass through, and find out what price for acre they would want for signing the right of way, Jimmie has a very bad cold the result of his soaking on Saturday, and of getting out of bed after taking Quinine, on Sunday night just at 12. A galloche of a man came to pay some money on a note that he was sued for the coat was on Monday the 19<sup>th</sup> Jimmie was at Court, and has not been out since Got from Mrs D'Ferguson (by Katie Christie), an enlarged photo of Red Mr Ferguson and an enlarged dengaratype of Sarah
- 20 Mild, looks like rain. Murdy off for Glen Donald
- 21 Murdy went to Cornwall, Fine in Morning turned ugly in afternoon about 4 another blizzard, which broke off a large limb from a maple in front next to the corner one
- 22 7/8 4 loaves 24, butter 1<sup>st</sup> to 1 gall coal oil 20
- 23 Fine day, Jimmie not so well got up after taking a sweat last night off 25. J. P. was down
- 24 Rain and stormy 7/8 2 loaves 12
- 25 Rain Ann did not come today, The river is very high, Mail did not go down in evening.
- 26 Rain and sleet, The trees are loaded with ice
- 27 Fine bright day, No Ann this week, The concert for the 59<sup>th</sup> company of Militia takes place to night in St Andrews Hall. 7/8 2 loaves 12

- 28. Fine cold day, The earth is covered with snow, and runners is all the go, Murdy left for Cornwall yesterday. The road between here and Lancaster was impassable for two days with ice and logs. The ice got jammed at the iron bridge, and it had to be blasted, the jam raised the water so high that it was likely to flood around the Station
- 29 Destructive floods in Ohio, Illinois Indiana some reports 10,000 lives lost and millions of property destroyed. In Dayton Ohio 500 were drowned. This is a fine day, the trees are still loaded with ice. Evening trees bare. 7/8 4 loaves 24  
3 lbs butter 9<sup>th</sup> 2 lbs lard 40
- 30 A good many out to Church May off 25
- 31 I was sick last night did not eat any supper I am just lounging today. It is an ugly stormy day thunder lightning and heavy rain Murdy left for Cornwall this morning
