

Sept 17<sup>th</sup> 1892.

Wed, 17. Fine and clear, but very hot. spent the evening at Mr. B. Sutherland's.

Thurs, 18. Another very hot day <sup>therm</sup> higher than yesterday being about 84°.

Fri, 19. Very hot all day, distant thunder, and a light dash of rain about 4 o'clock turning cooler at night. with the appearance of rain, much in the N. West. - Later in the night there was considerable heavy thunder and sharp lightning, but very little rain.

Sat, 20. A little rain in the morning not of any account, very cool all day, sky covered with heavy blue clouds at night having the appearance of cold weather.

Aug 21<sup>st</sup> 1892.

Sun, 21. Most beautiful day fine and cool. except at about noon, it being quite warm then.

Mon, 22. Lovely all day cool and pleasant rendering it pleasant for working.

Tue, 23. Fine all day, getting quite warm in the evening, and late on about midnight there was considerable thunder but very little rain.

Wed, 24. Raining a little this morning nothing to speak of, heavy thunder showers passed north, fine all day until evening when it began raining accompanied with much thunder and lightning continuing all night, was at Mrs. Lowens during the evening. she being afraid of thunder & lightning.
