money. M. muting could not get into
the Postry so came here my offering 25
- 7 Friday doing not much had visitors
- 8 Pa got about six bush potatoes from Whit
ford some as small as bullets, out many
fit to eat, Murdy came home last night
Hatty came today she had been up
the Branch. Lillian McLennan and
Mc. McLaurin were our visitors yesterday
Sent a letter to Ran with \$10⁰⁰
- 9 Rev Mathewson preached, morning & evening
Given was at his church in morning at
Lancaster in the evening, the subjects
was Niprins
- 10 Very fine in the morning, now looks
like rain, we are to send milk but
three times a week
