Began to sow & sowed 5 1/2 bushel of Chinnie Wheat in the field below the Bull pasture ground very dry  
Sowed 7 bushel of peas at Crestes place 3 of them I got from John Yorange Sowed the Hungarian grass seed in the garden  
split rails at Crestes in the fore noon went to a raising of a house of Mr Mc Clearys in the afternoon very warm & dry weather  
Sowed 7 bushel of poll oats at Crestes  
Sowed 9 bushel of oats 4 of them I got of John Yorange they are next Edgley's line very warm & dry no rain this Spring yet  
the Rev Mr McKenzie preached in Caintown  
Grandpa went to Lynn yesterday & came home to Day on foot to the Quarterly meeting  
David finished dragging at Crestes & planted corn in the garden put plaster in the drill the first row next the Barn next row leached ashes then 3 rows with achis split rails at Crestes John Edgley helped very warm  
sowed 1 1/2 bushel of Rye next the Barn David plowed there I yesterday plumb Trees in full blossom  
laid up the fence at the foot of the hill at Crestes  
laid up the fence next the woods at Crestes  
went to Larsons vill with 32 pinkens & to Muller vill 10 to Dorris 14 to Green warm day  
the Rev Mr Wilson preached in caintown  
sowed 5 bushel of Scotch wheat 2 of it I got from Mr Lawson & 3 from Ferguson the first 4 ridges is Lawsons the Fergusons at in the west of the Barn  
David plowed the potato ground & helped Jack to plant very dry weather  
I trained some dry lambs of the Apples trees & spread dung for the corn
