17 Cleared 20 bays Wheat A M I took it
to Spink's Mills @ 93 cts P M B & H
helped M. Craig to finish threshing
W. drizzly A M. very high wind &
squalls of snow P M Cold & ground white

18 B helped I & D's Thrust I & A Cleared out
Hen house & drew in some stones I &
Nancy went to Flavin's A M & to White
vale P M W. very Cold this morning
ground white with snow
19 Boys finished plowing hen house
with stones then covered it with earth
& began plowing & desaping a ditch
east of dam to turn over flowing
water into Creek. I walked to
Whitevale P M to order a heavy
Chain with B. Alison & a heavy
set of harness with A. Armstrong
W. Mildly pretty windy P M getting
20 Boys worked at ditch at dam awhile
A M I plowed in sod A helped awhile
A M then B & A helped H level
dirt that came out of turnip Cellar
P M I nearly finished walls at Cel
lar door I & Susanna took Butter
to Lewis he is paying 22 cts this
good while W. fin. Mild. Cloudy
I went to J. K. Reason's this morning
to tell him that we built the Culvert
21 I helped level dirt A M I B & A & Henry
Picked load of Cider apples. began to
rain soon after dinner rained till night
