Saturday 27

Didn't get much sleep the night before so was rather tired when bed time came so the Buck Bros. went to roost early.

Sunday 28

Roscoe helped me with the milk route so that we were all through by 11.10 A.M. Called at the hospital on the way home to see Carl's cat and took the fellows in a few bottles of good milk. Had a lovely time at Jean's at night and Eldin Gurney for lunch. Ling brought Roscoe and I home in a hurry. La bid at one velvet.
