- Wed Feb 13. Fine and mild. Ash Wednesday. Aunt Mattie to see Siggie Bowers last time, I went snow shoveling with Annie in evening.
- Thur Feb 14. Fine and mild, untill evening heavy thunder storms, lightning, colder.
- Fri Feb 15. Fine with terrific wind and cold. Annie here in evening.
- Sat Feb 16. Fine but cold east wind. Siggie Bowers died. blustery evening ^{very road} _{watery}
- Sun Feb 17. Fine and moderately cold. I went to Bowers in morning. I went to ev. church.
- Mon Feb 18. Fine bright day, moderated. We went to Siggie Bowers funeral. Mrs Peasdale here for tea. I went to girls Hockey match in evening.
- Tue Feb 19. Rained heavily then foggy, water coming up a little, high in night.

- Sat Feb 23. Fine bright day, quite mild but no water. Saurer James here for tea. Annie called. I went to Punk in evening.
- Sun Feb 24. Fine bright day, very mild. Aunt Nellie at morning church. Aunt M. called at mother's. Mrs Clarke called. Willie & Mary here. stayed tea water over road in eve - I was not out. had cold.
