Very stormy day mostly sunny, frosty, snowing and blowing. Willie and I each took a heifer (Duncie and Friday sold to Wm Shortreed on Monday) over to his place in AM. In PM Arthur Perry and J. Michie came with span and took two loads. Sam McLee & Clark and us up to Cinnabark to vote. Gibson and Craig candidates for M. P. P. mother up in PM. Willie drove down. Paid Danderen 7.2.00

Willie drove Mary down town in PM she got at Steels flannel and spools 41 cent Armstrongs 20 also store blacking 10 rice 25 gave on it 15 eggs 27cts sold butter to Wm McLean 2.28 gave buttons annual meeting 57cts.
